THE MOST HOLY BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST

First Reading: Genesis 14:18-20

Melchizedek, a priest of God, prayed that Abram would be blessed by God. He also praised God for delivering Abram's foes into his hands.

Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 11:23-26

Paul describes Jesus' actions during the last supper. Jesus broke bread and said it was his body given for us, asking that we do the same in remembrance of him. He then passed the cup and called it his blood. Jesus then asked us to break bread in this manner to remember his death until he returns.

Gospel: Luke 9:11b-17

Jesus spoke to a large crowd when his disciples asked that he dismiss the people to give them a chance to find food and lodging. Jesus asked the disciples to give the crowd something to eat, but they had only five loaves of bread and two fish. Jesus then blessed and distributed the food, which fed about 5,000 people. Twelve baskets were then collected from what was left over.

CARDINAL'S APPEAL

You may have or will receive shortly a **follow-up letter** from Cardinal Dolan regarding the **STATUS of the Appeal** in our parish. As of 5/20, 152 gifts have been made, totaling \$75,630.00. Our goal has been set at \$106,000. Last year we had 160 donors at around this time. We met our goal and the parish received a substantial rebate. This year we hoped to increase the number of donors to around 220_. Therefore I am asking parishioners who have not responded yet to make their pledge or donation. Thank you to all who have already responded.

REFUGEE ASSISTANCE

Holy Innocents Church is sponsoring four refugee families that have been resettled by the Archdiocese of New York in answer to Pope Francis' call for Refugee Assistance. They are refugees from Burma, West Africa, and Honduras (2). **We can help too!** Needed especially are new bedding (twin and queen size sheets and blankets, bath and kitchen towels and all sorts of toiletries, school supplies, etc.).
