### **FIFTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME**

#### **First Reading: Deuteronomy 30:10-14**

Moses petitions the people to follow the commandments God has set before them. He reminds them that the laws are not in the sky or far away at sea, but are accessible to them and meant to be followed if they wish to prosper.

#### **Second Reading: Colossians 1:15-20**

Paul discusses the divine nature of Jesus, and explains that Jesus was created before anything else. Everything else was "created through him, and for him."

#### **Gospel: Luke 10:25-37**

While discussing everlasting life, a lawyer mentions loving one's neighbor as oneself. The lawyer then asks Jesus, "Who is my neighbor?" Jesus tells him about a man beaten by robbers, who was ignored by both a priest and a Levite before a Samaritan stopped and offered him aid. Jesus asks the lawyer who was neighbor to the injured man. The lawyer says, "the one who treated him with compassion." Jesus encourages him to go and do the same.

### **BUILDING AND GROUNDS UPDATE**

You might have seen the dumpster outside the rectory. It contained the debris from necessary plumbing repairs due to a major 3<sup>rd</sup> floor leak. It basically necessitated a lot of destruction to correct the following repairs to put it all back together with some improvements. Expect to see some scaffolding around the Church in the next few weeks as we have submitted a request and accompanying bids and documentation to the Archdiocese for approval. I am sure you have seen the damage we have to repair. By the fall we will have a custom made entrance door at Our Lady of the Wayside, and a new exit door to the OLW parking lot is already installed. Both have been deteriorating. Slowly but surely we are improving the appearance of our grounds and are analyzing the Shrine of St. Theresa for another project.

### **WHY WE OPPOSE ASSISTED SUICIDE**

- **American Medical Association** – "allowing physicians to participate in assisted suicide would cause more harm than good. Physician-assisted suicide is fundamentally incompatible with the physician's role as healer, would be difficult or impossible to control, and would pose serious societal risks"
- **The NYS Task Force on Life and the Law** – "we unanimously recommend that New York retain its prohibition of assisted suicide and euthanasia. After extensive study, we conclude that legalizing these practices would be profoundly dangerous for large segments of the population.
- **Profit-driven health insurance programs** – would be given the opportunity to cut costs by denying payment for more expensive treatments while approving payment for less costly assisted-suicide deaths.
- **It sends the message that suicide is acceptable** – "New York spends millions of dollars each year to prevent suicides. Suicides rates have risen to a 30 year high since Assisted Suicide has been legalized in Oregon!
- **New York could easily become a national suicide destination.**
- **Doctor-prescribed suicide will become just another treatment option.**
