NINETEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

First Reading: 1 Kings 19:9a, 11-13a

After fleeing from the revenge of the King of Israel, Elijah hid in a cave, but at the command of God, he went outside and stood on a mountain. There the Lord came to him, not in the wind nor in the earthquake, but in a "tiny whispering sound.

Second Reading: Romans 9:1-5

Paul is deeply pained because the Jews - in spite of everything that has been given to them - have rejected Christ.

Gospel: Matthew 14:22-33

Matthew vividly recounts the event of Jesus walking on the water. When the disciples see this, they are terrified, and Jesus chastises them for their fear. Peter begs Christ to let him walk on the water; he is at first brave but begins to sink and loses faith, crying out, "Lord save me!" Christ rescues him for his faltering faith.

RENEW AND REBUILD

The New York Archdiocese "**Renew and Rebuild**" **campaign** will soon begin at St. Theresa and Our Lady of the Wayside. This is a major **five-year capital campaign** which **will address the infrastructure needs at our parish and support important Archdiocesan objectives**. Monies raised will be shared (26% to Archdiocese, 74% to St. Theresa) and the first year of this campaign will replace the 2018 Cardinal's Appeal. The Archdiocesan Cardinal's Appeal will return in 2019.

We will identify specific areas that are in need at St. Theresa and Our Lady of the Wayside. Interior repairs and painting are already out for bidding and will be paid out from the parish proceeds portion. The replacement of the organ at St. Theresa is currently being investigated and will also be paid for out of our parish share of "Renew and Rebuild."

Additional projects will be scheduled based upon the amount of funds raised.
